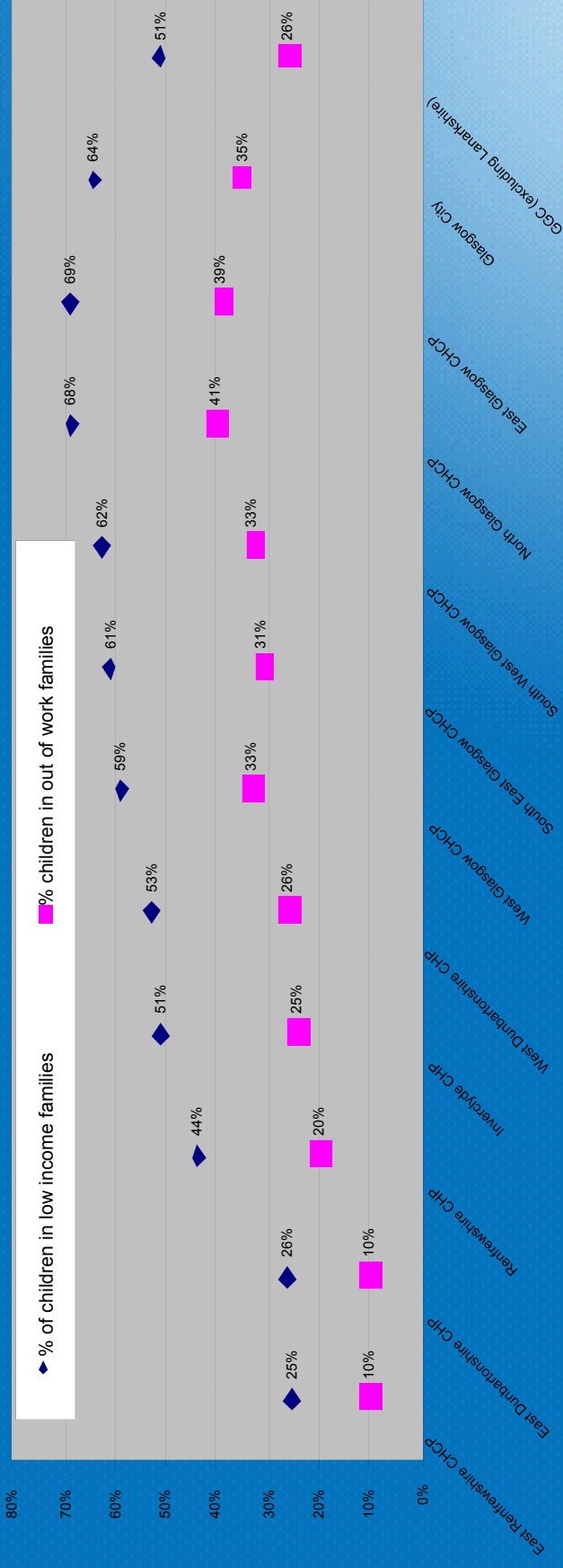
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Children in workless and in low-income families

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As economic circumstances get tighter what evidence (outcomes) demonstrate the effectiveness of interventions to managers, and will allow further investment in children's (health) services?

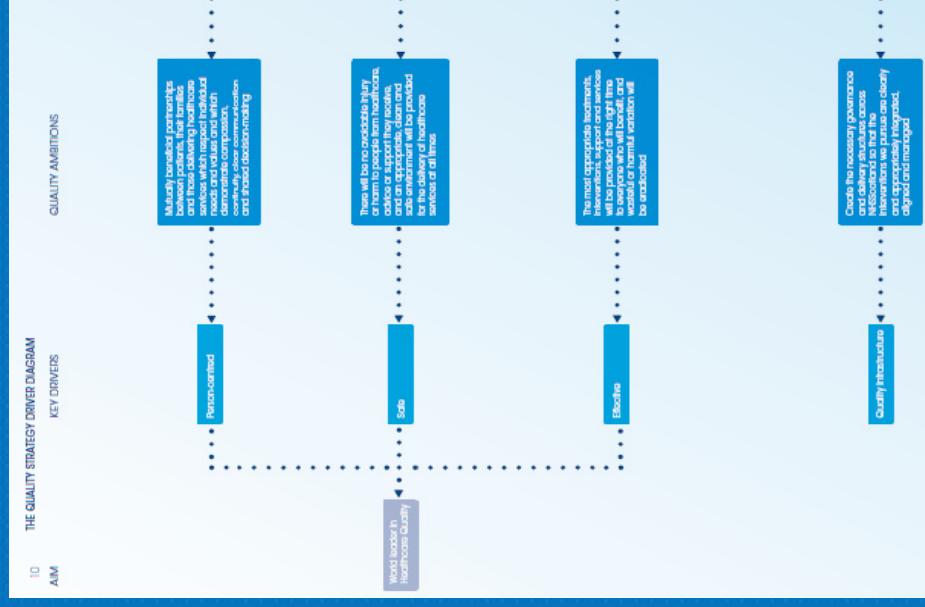

There will be no avoidable injury or harm to people from healthcare, advice or support they receive, and an appropriate, clean and safe environment will be provided for the delivery of healthcare services at all times

QUALITY AMBITIONS

The most appropriate treatments, interventions, support and services will be provided at the right time to everyone who will benefit, and wasteful or harmful variation will be eradicated

Create the necessary governance and delivery structures across NHS Scotland so that the interventions we pursue are clearly and appropriately integrated, aligned and managed
